

Senator Election Results Spring 2018

The following are the results from the Spring 2018 SGA Senator Elections. The results will be divided by campus residence hall cluster, and will include information on any abnormalities that may have occurred or appear in the voting totals.

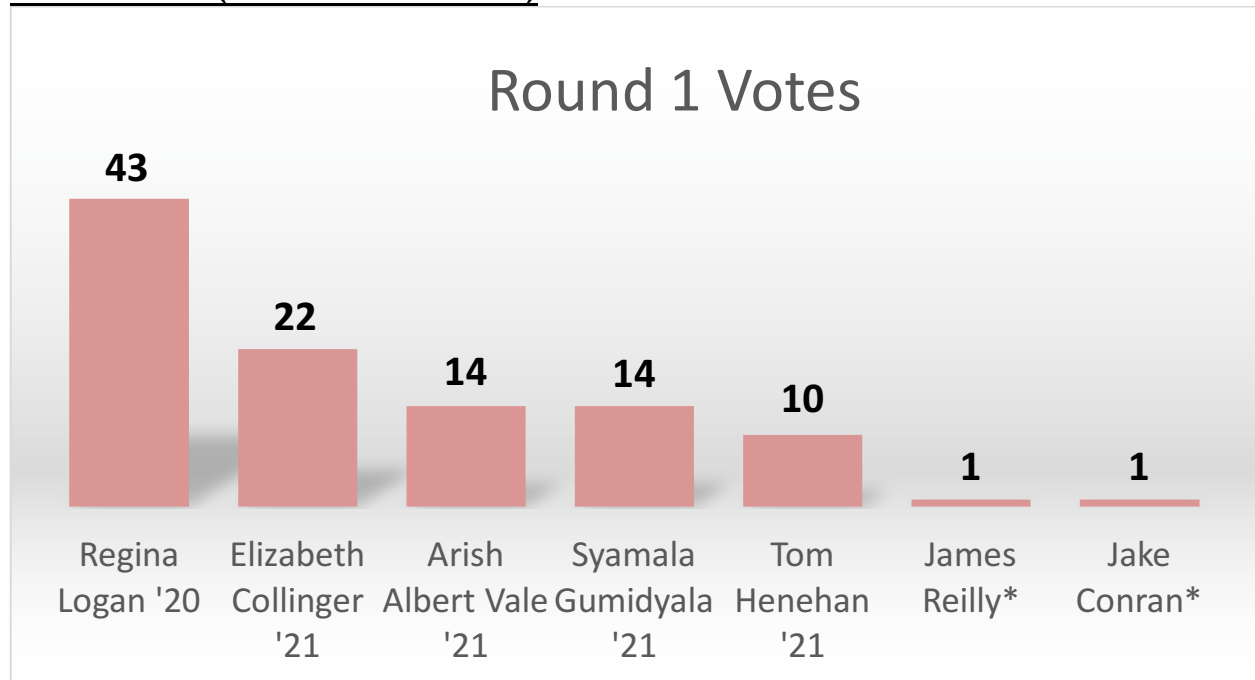
The standard practice for counting and recording these votes is as follows:

1. Count votes for each candidate.
2. Remove the candidate with the lowest number of votes.
3. Apply the second-choice votes of the removed candidates to the candidates which still remain.
4. Re-tally the votes and repeat the elimination process until the appropriate amount of candidates remain.
5. In the case of “No Confidence” winning a position, the SGA cabinet will appoint a senator to the position.

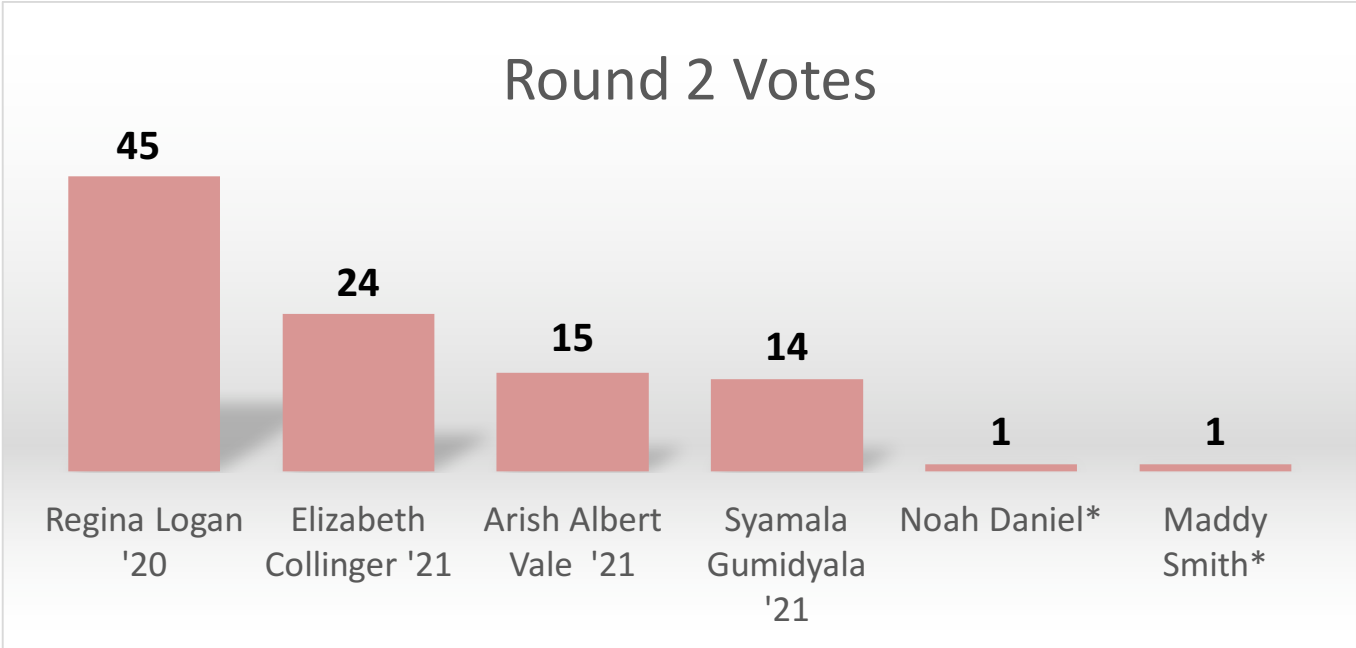
*Asterisks indicate write-in candidates.

→ Any reduction in total number of votes shown on the graphs below are due to later-preference votes being assigned to No Confidence, and are therefore not shown.

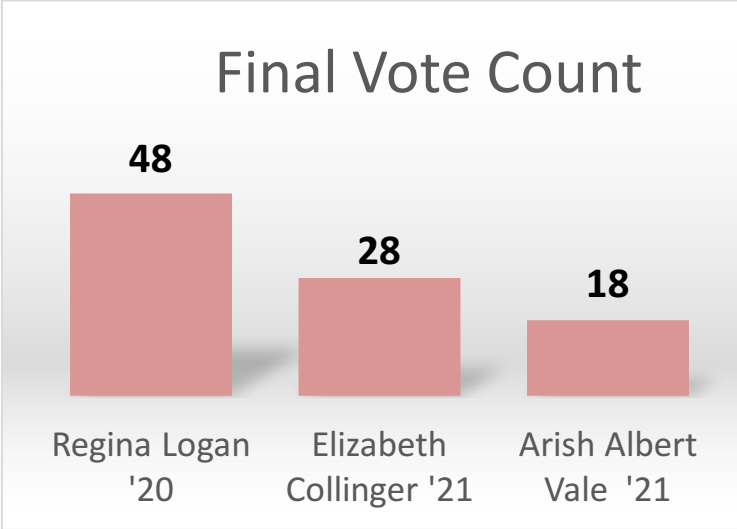
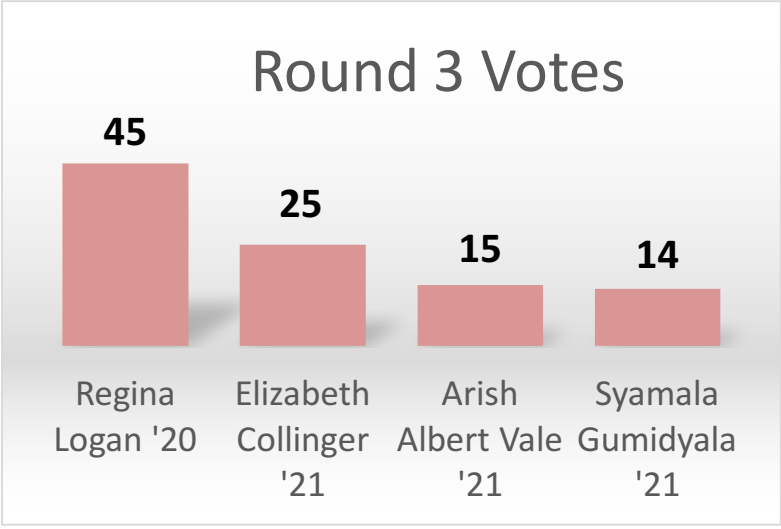
LaKeRoJe (3 available seats)



Both write-in candidates and Tom were eliminated as there is no way they could surpass the other candidates. This left Regina, Elizabeth, Arish and Syamala as candidates.

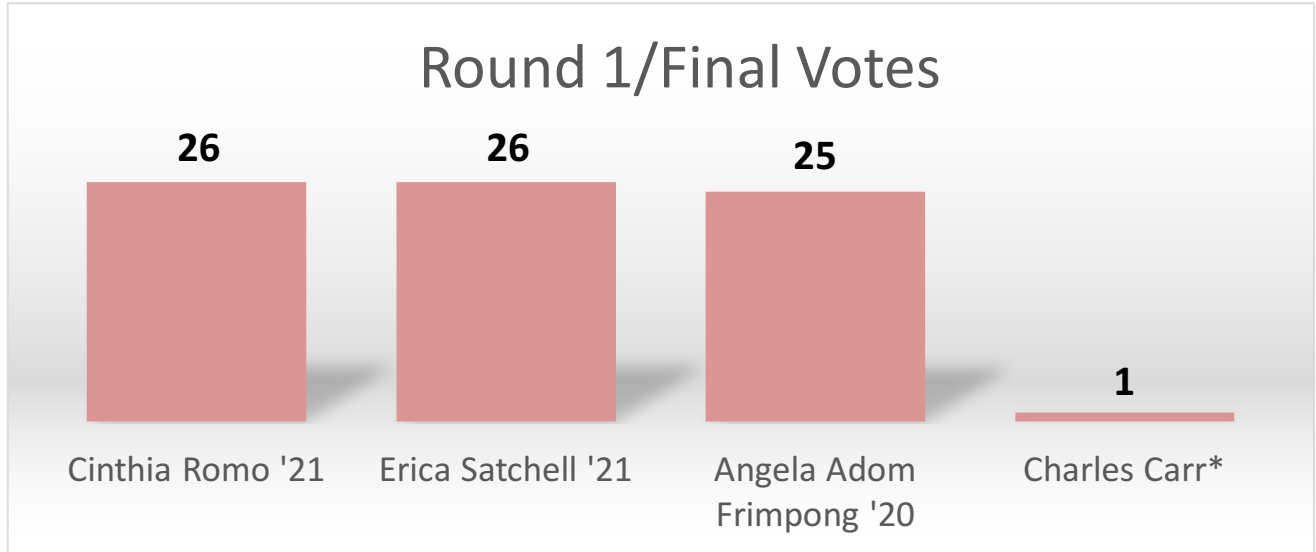


Noah Daniel and Maddy Smith emerged as write-in candidates as second-preferences, while other votes were distributed as shown, and were then eliminated.



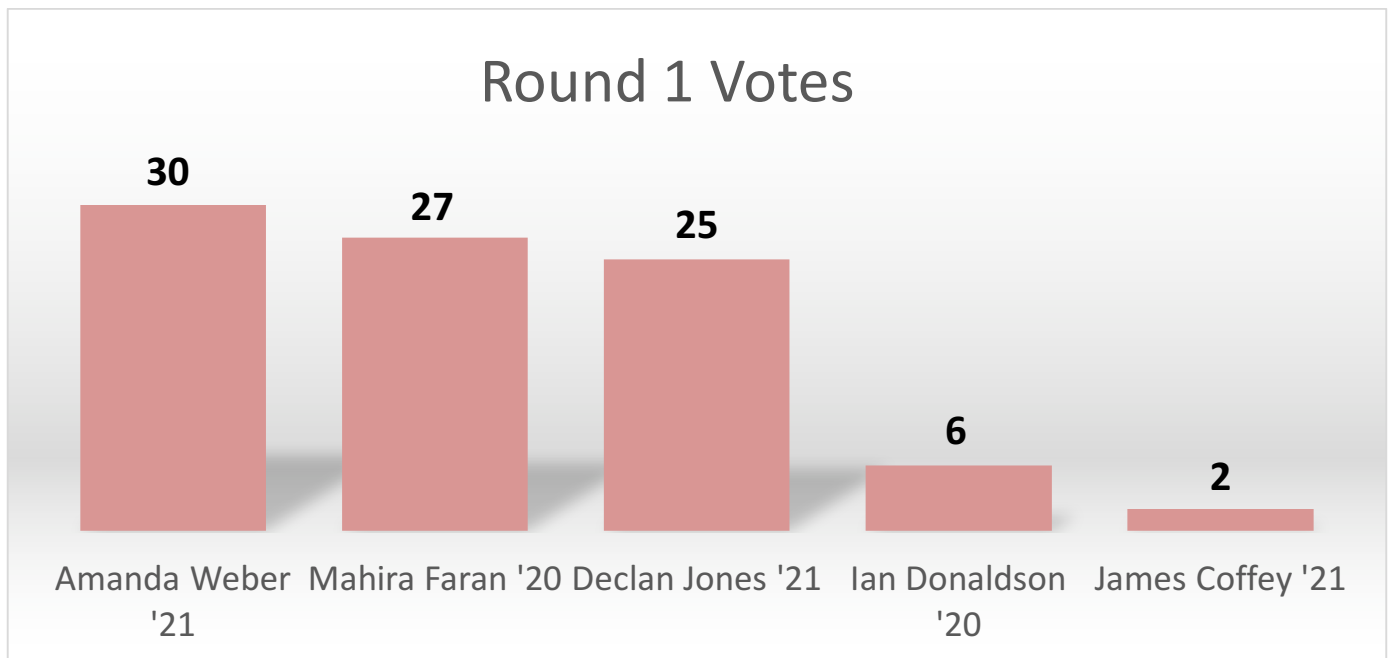
Votes from the two write-ins were distributed as shown. This eliminated Syamala, leaving Regina, Elizabeth and Arish as the LaKeRoJe senators. Final vote counts are shown on the right.

Canada (3 available seats)

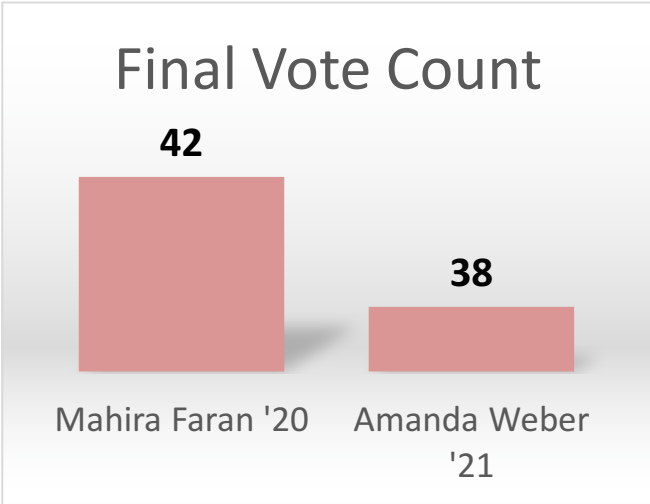
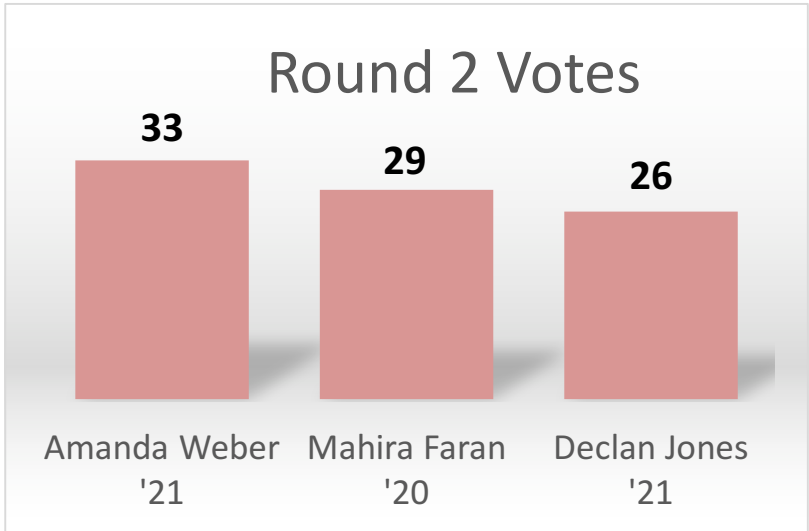

Jamaland (2 available seats)

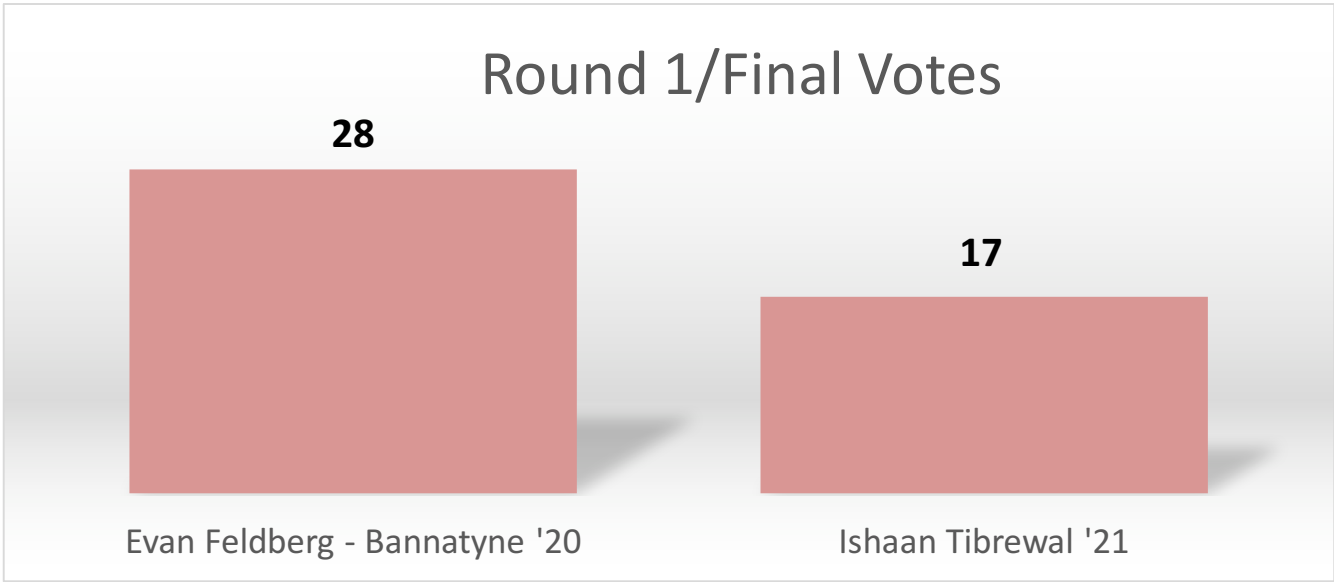


Ian and James were eliminated and their votes redistributed to Amanda, Mahira, and Declan.



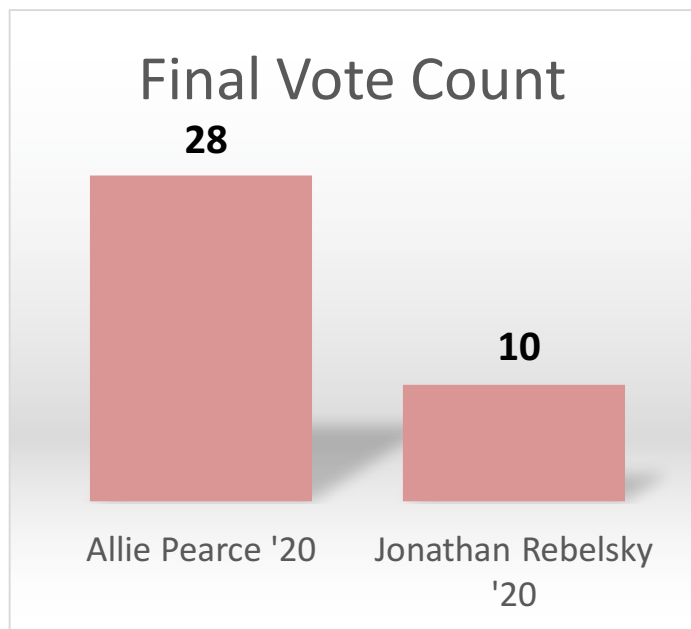
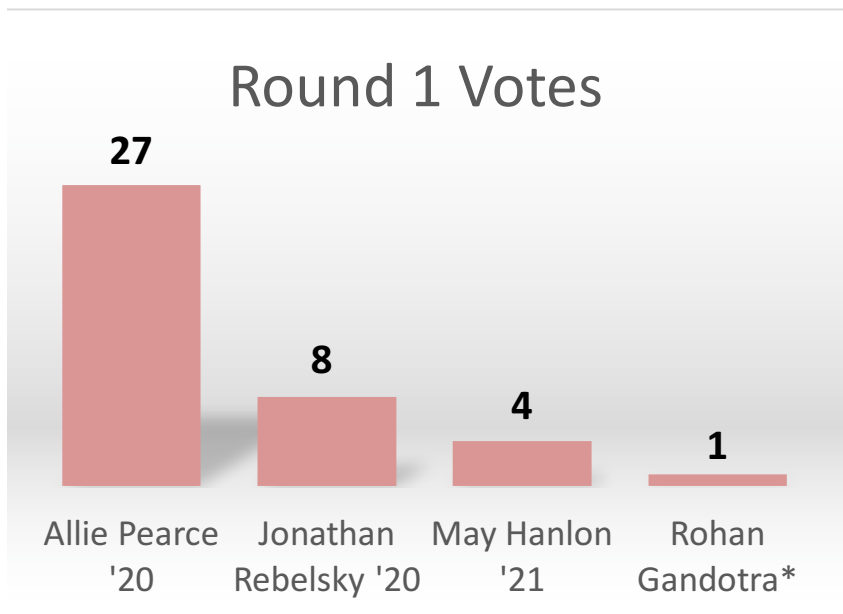
After redistribution into Round 2, Declan was eliminated leaving Mahira and Amanda as the senators and the final vote counts as seen on the right.

Votes only went to Evan, Ishaan, or No Confidence. This left the first round as the final one, and Evan and Ishaan as senators

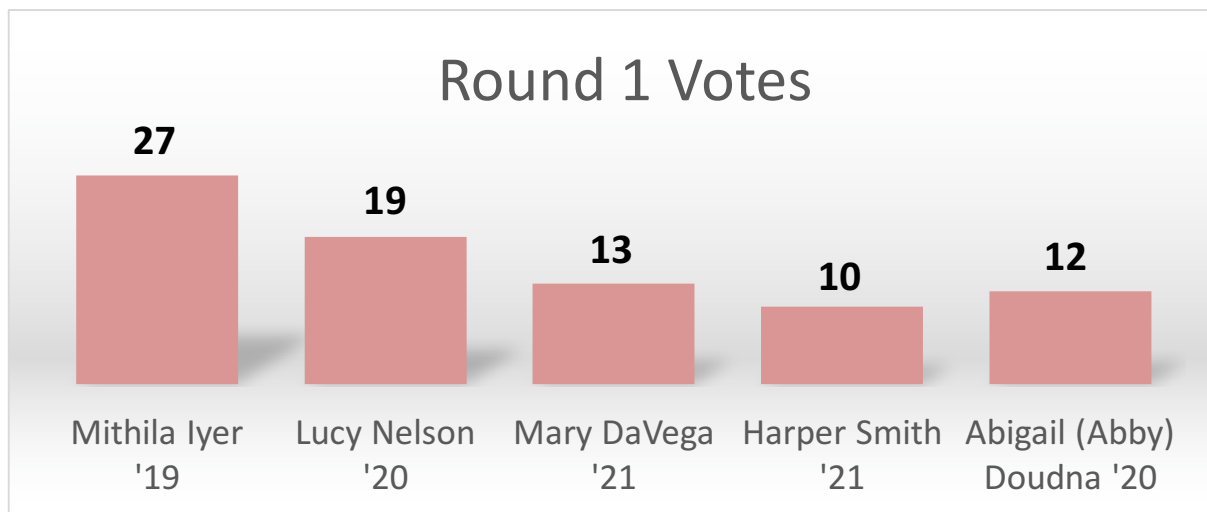
Smonker (2 available seats)

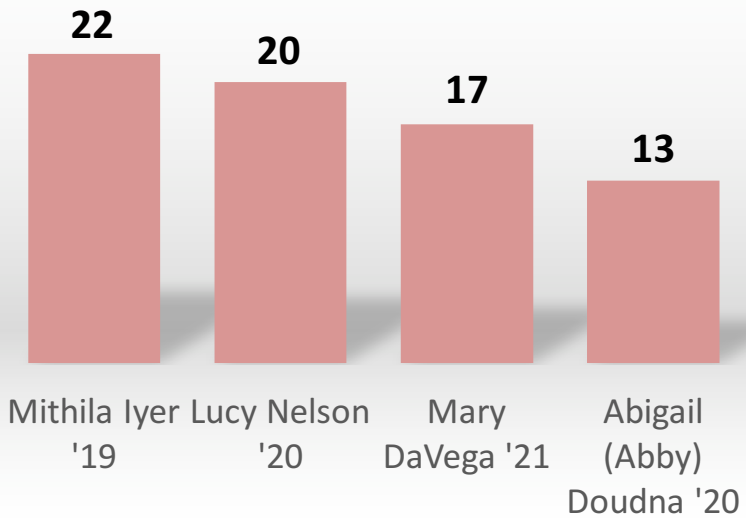
Loosehead (3 available seats)

Kadiata Toumbou withdrew her candidacy from the election and her votes were redistributed.

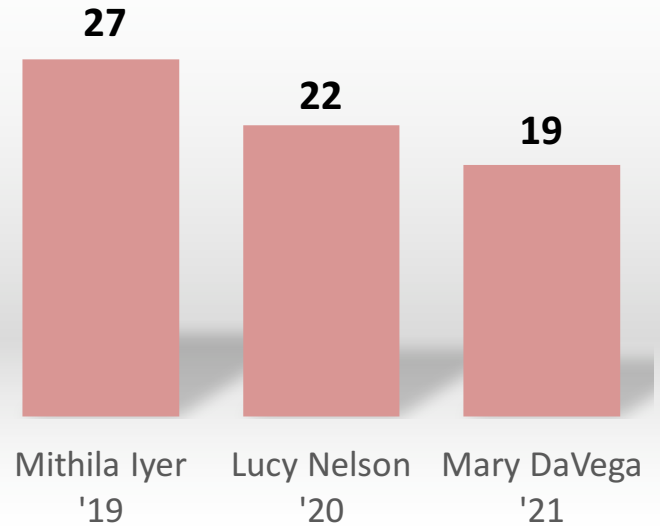


Both Harper was eliminated, This left Mithila, Lucy, Abby, and Mary as remaining candidates for Round 2.

Final Vote Count

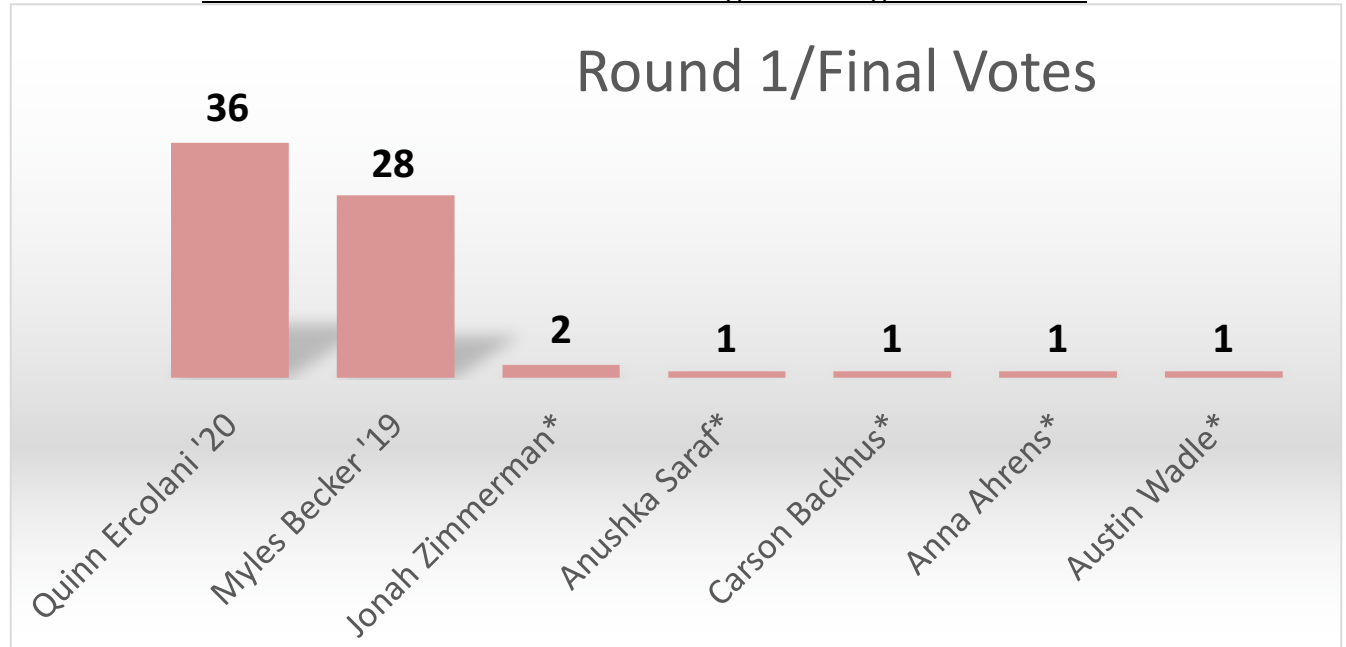


Following redistribution, Abby was eliminated, leaving Mithila, Mary and Lucy as the three senators. Their final vote counts are shown on the right.
