**VPSA Epps:**

- The execs are going to present; Current standards & proposed change

**President White:**



- Current constitutional prereqs of cabinet and paid SGA staff

**VPAA Gelnarova**

- Good conduct standing will be added to the positions in constitutions. If you violate the student handbook, you'll go to JudCo who will determine if you are in violation of the student handbook or you will go in front of the college hearing board. They will determine if you're found responsible or not responsible for going against handbook. If you're not found responsible, you will remain in good standing.

**President White**

- SGA leaders should be responsible. Should not have behavior that goes against our values.

**Senator Feldberg-Bannatyne**

- Point of information: a new study reveals it's closer to 1 in 4

**President White**

- Currently, we have no way to impeach those who are found responsible for sexual assault.

**VPAA Gelnarova**

- Process: will go through Dean Moschenross to figure out who has violated and who has not. It is completely confidential. She will run names through records to see who is or is not in good conduct standing.

**VPSA Epps**

- She'd get applications immediately, then she filters them, then we will get the filtered list. We wouldn't know about the people who applied and were turned away by dean moschenross. that would violate many laws.

**President White**

- If passed, people probably wouldn't apply if not in good conduct standing. Would take into effect immediately.

**VPSA Epps:**

- We want to get it passed asap, because we want the people who will be in our jobs next year will go through this process.

**President White**

- We need 20% of student body to vote; we need 2/3 to approve

**Senator Romo**

- Why can't we wait until next campus council to pass it?

**President White:**

- We can, but we prefer to do it now, because forms are due for execs this week

**Assistant Treasurer Sheikh**

- What's the difference between campus council and all campus vote

**President White**

- If Campus Council approves, then there will be an all campus election

**Senator Weber:** We have nothing in place for impeachment of those who are in good conduct standing, so why not focus on that?

**VPSA Epps**

- Technically, if you are in bad conduct standing, you don't misuse your position, so technically it doesn't make sense to impeach you given our processes.

**President White**

- We could revisit that, but this is our first step.

**Senator Davega:** Who determines criteria under good conduct standing? Does stipulation about drugs include all drugs?

**VPAA Gelnarova**

- Definition in student handbook. all drugs are included. anything that is not non-prescription or over the counter.

**Senator Feldberg-Bannatyne**

- Can you point out the explicit definition?

**VPAA Gelnarova**

- Our school determines good conduct standing. only includes school processes, not necessarily legal processes.

**Senator Ercolani**

- We do have a way to impeach sga officials if a case arises through the impeachment process. I am somewhat worried that we would have sga officials screened by administration; calls into question our autonomy. why do we need this in the constitution if it is already in the bylaws? is it just for redundancy's sake?

**P.O Riley**

- You'll all get an email soon about the specific policies.

**Senator Logan**

- Can you find it anywhere in the handbook?

**Senator Rebelsky**

- point of info: good conduct standing appears nowhere in the student handbook

**President White**

- Yes, there are methods for impeachment, but not specifically regarding conduct standing. I was also worried about admins doing this, but I was assured by Sarah Moschenross and Chinyere who is the ombudsperson. I trust the student body in their ability to pick

candidates, but students wouldn't know if students were on bad conduct standing or not. It's important to include in constitution so its consistent with the bylaws.

**Senator Faran**

- What led to the admin deciding they wanted to put this in place? who makes distinction between accused and guilty of sexual harassment? is there no way for jroc to be a part of decision making process?

**VPSA Epps:**

- Administration did not bring this forward. we learned that previous execs have been sexual assaulters and there was nothing we can do about it. They explain good conduct standing in handbook.

**Senator Collinger**

- Is there three strikes for warnings?

**VPAA Gelnarova**

- If you're found responsible several times, then you might have more serious outcomes?

**Senator Logan**

- I voted yes last semester because my initial idea was that I don't want an abuser in SGA. but as people have come to me with this issue, I've realized that good conduct standing doesn't necessarily do that , but instead reinforces college's standards. There are plenty of people on good standing that shouldn't be and plenty of people on bad conduct standing that shouldn't be. The fact that this hasn't been worked through on reform or generally is really disappointing. Admin should work with us to find better language. The description for good conduct standing is jargony and gets into a grey area

**Senator Rebelsky**

- If you are accused of sexual assault, are you immediately placed in bad conduct standing?

**VPAA Gelnarova**

- I don't know. I work with JudCo and CBH, but I would assume you are in good conduct until found responsible, but I can check on that.

**Senator Nelson**

- I want to reiterate Senator Logan's point that grey areas lead to disproportionately harm those who are historically oppressed. Language on retaliation and drug use in conduct book unfairly harms survivors of sexual assault.

**Co-ACCESS Director Benloch**

- Maybe a more narrow definition of good conduct standing that is just connected to sexual assault is better. the only process we put through ACCESS workers through is the title ix process. This is better.

**Senator Vale**

- I think the clearest thing is ambiguity but process to avoid having abusers on campus is valid. However, it should be codified.

#### **Concerts Chair jarzyna**

- Thanks for sharing everyone. I'm definitely glad you all have something to hear about that. I think we should have community based conversation about this.

#### **President White**

- This is something I've been thinking about for quite some time. I met with Chinyere, Mark Watts, Sarah Moschenross, and Andrea Conner about this. I'm open to other approaches about this, but we should wrap this up soon so we can discuss ideas that we can implement before February. This is a standard for Community Advisors. The definition of good conduct standing is intentionally ambiguous. Also, Title IX does not cover all behaviors such as threats of violence and violence.

#### **VPAA Gelnarova**

- Application to be on JudCo come out at the end of the year. If you want to see how the process works, I urge you to look at it.

#### **Treasurer Steckel**

- No one seems to have any ideas for another option. Let's have more conversations and talk about it.

#### **Candace Mettle:**

- I want to respond to President White. Ambiguity is not a good thing, especially given the examples we've heard tonight. Good conduct standing deals largely with nonviolent conduct.

#### **President White**

- This is a thing we can do, not necessarily the whole answer.

#### **Assistant Treasurer Sheikh**

- Why can't only Chinyere just do it? Judco is just students? Do they have access to confidential information?

#### **President White**

- This is Sarah's actual job, while Chinyere does a bunch of other things. Students know the situation, but not the full conduct case. Sarah will often go forward with JudCo decision unless she has record of conduct in the report that makes the decision not right.

#### **Assistant Treasurer Sheikh**

- Chinyere should do it. Admin hires admins, SGA hires SGA. Chinyere is neutral-body.

#### **Senator Logan**

- How can we model self-governance not just to model this one resource that isn't actually great that students don't trust? How can we figure out a way in our community to make this happen?
